"It's about 100 meters out from the next closest tent and the lethaka reed side wall to the loo (complete with a termite mound) is only about a meter high so you feel alone and in the bush -- my personal favorite tent. I had a barred owl neighbor out there, a visiting genet, and the spoor of a leopard but lion' eating over takes it to a new level. Of course Tent #1 isn't nearly as isolated but Doctor told me the dog pack has made 3 kills right in front of that tent. What a masterpiece that camp is."

Basic nomination criteria include:

- the property must be located in a wildlife reserve (national or private), or within at most an hour's travel from extensive wildlife (game, bird or marine life), and must not be located in a city or a large town
- the property must offer wildlife viewing excursions, whether big game or marine wildlife tourism viewing
- the property must feasibly be part of the 'safari circuit'- somewhere visitors will stay as part of their safari holiday

Sankuyo Bush Camp is situated on the south eastern edge of the Okavango Delta. The camp is accessible by light aircraft or 4x4 vehicles. On arrival guests are met at the airstrip and welcomed to the camp. Accommodation consists of six Meru style tents with en-suite facilities. The activities at Sankuyo Bush Camp are day and night game drives, with a guide and tracker. Guests usually go out in the early morning, having a late breakfast on their return, and again in the afternoon after the midday heat. Then return just after dark for an African dinner
